

Entry Guidelines:

- -Submit up to 3 images on Smarter Entry https://client.smarterentry.com/NAWAMA
- -Artwork professionally wired for hanging and be for sale during the entire show and be for sale during the entire show
- -In the event of a sale: 100% to the Artist as there will be listed prices, and Steven Pennell, Founder and Coordinator of Arts and Culture at the University of Rhode Island, will connect interested buyers to the Artist

Instructions:

- -2-D work under 5' X 5'
- -3-D and wall-hung sculptural work there are pedestals available, but there are size limits and weight restrictions for both wall-mounted and standing sculptures. Large-sized sculptures, heavy sculptures, and special installation requirements need to be approved prior
- -Pastel works must be display ready under plexiglass
- -Metal or wood frames preferred. Unframed artwork must be finished on all sides.
