-Artwork professionally wired for hanging and be for sale during the entire show

-**In the event of a sale:** 100% to the Artist as BAM only facilitates

Instructions:

-2-D work (no maximum size)

-3-D and wall-hung sculptural work (pedestal provided and wall-hung no maximum size)

-Pastel works must be display ready under plexiglass

-Metal or wood frames preferred. Unframed artwork must be finished on all sides.
